## Notice – Pattern of Question Paper of JECA-2022

- 1 Pattern of Question Papers.** The Common Entrance Test will be on one paper only based on Basic Computer Application with following structure.

All questions will be of **Multiple-Choice Question (MCQ)** type, with four answer options. Time for the paper is 2 hours. The questions will be in **English language only**.

- 2 Syllabus:** The papers will be based on Undergraduate Computer Application course followed in various Universities in India.

**3 Scoring Methodology**

a) Category 1:

- Only one option is correct.
- Correct option will yield 1 (one) mark
- Incorrect option will yield  $-\frac{1}{4}$  (negative  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) marks.
- For any combination of more than one option, even if it contains the correct option, the said answer will be treated as incorrect and will yield  $-\frac{1}{4}$  (negative  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) marks.
- Not attempting the question will fetch 0 marks.

b) Category 2:

- One or more options is/are correct.
- Marking all correct options only will yield 2 (two) marks.
- For any combination of answers containing one or more incorrect options, the said answer will be treated as incorrect, and it will yield zero (0) mark even if one or more of the chosen options is/are correct.
- For partially correct answers, i.e., when all correct options are not marked and also no incorrect options are marked, marks awarded =  $2 \times (\text{no of correct options marked}) / (\text{total no of actually correct options})$
- Not attempting the question will fetch 0 marks
