NOTIFICATION – MOP-UP COUNSELLING – PUBDET-2019

The State Government vide **West Bengal Act XIV of 2014** enacted **The West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board Act, 2014** and is empowered to conduct Common Entrance Examinations for selection of candidates for admission to undergraduate and postgraduate Professional, Vocational and General Degree Courses in the State of West Bengal and to conduct the on-line counselling process or otherwise adopting a single-window approach.

And whereas, for the academic session 2019–20, the Board after conducting the Common Entrance Examination (**PUBDET-2019**) for admission to Undergraduate Courses in three-year B.A./B.Sc. (Honours) courses in the Presidency University, has already conducted two consecutive rounds of counselling and subsequent provisional admission, where all SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PwD candidates and sufficient number of General category candidates registered for counselling were called.

And whereas, the Presidency University has now intimated that some vacancies have further come up and requested WBJEEB to conduct a final round of Mop-Up counselling. As such the Board will conduct a Mop-Up round of counselling as per the details given below.

Candidates must go through this Notification very carefully and **it is to be construed that the candidate participating in the Mop-Up round agrees to all terms and conditions given hereunder and notices published in this regard.**

1. Eligibility for participation in Mop-Up round of counselling.

1.1. All candidates registered for counselling of PUBDET-2019, except those who have been given provisional admission in any subject in round-1 or round-2, are eligible for participating in Mop-Up round.

Also, as usual, all candidates, irrespective of their birth category, are eligible for 'general' seats provided the academic criteria for general seats (as specified in clause 3.2 of Information Bulletin) are met.

1.2. The candidates must fulfil the eligibility criteria as is mentioned in clause no. 3.2 of the PUBDET-2019 Information Bulletin.

1.3. The candidate must pass in English language and in all the best 4 subjects based on which the aggregate marks is to be calculated for determining eligibility.

1.4. All verifications are to be done during counselling and subsequent admission and registration with the university. If it is found on scrutiny at any stage that the applicant is otherwise ineligible, his/her admission shall stand cancelled

even if he/she has secured a Merit Rank in the PUBDET-2019 and/or a seat has been allotted to the candidate. Hence, securing a Rank in the PUBDET-2019 does not constitute a right/guarantee in favour of a candidate for his/her claim for admission if he/she fails to comply with the specified rules.

- 1.5. Any candidate found producing counterfeit/fraudulent documents will be immediately handed over to the police.
- 1.6. Any person found creating any form of disturbance/hindrance in the process of counselling will be debarred from counselling and admission and to be sent off from the counselling venue.
2. **Availability of seats:** See [annexure-I](#).
3. **Admission for Reserved Category of Students:** Please refer to clauses 5.0 to 9.0 of the PUBDET-2019 Information Bulletin.
4. **Legal Jurisdiction:**
 - 4.1. All matters pertaining to conduct of PUBDET – 2019 e-counselling shall fall within the jurisdiction of Calcutta only.
 - 4.2. The Board will not be a party pertaining to any dispute arising in the process of admission to any course of study through PUBDET – 2019.
5. **Steps of counselling:**
 - 5.1. The candidates will have to report at the counselling venue on the scheduled date and within the reporting time, failing which the candidate will not be allowed to participate in the counselling under any circumstances.
 - 5.2. Candidates reporting within the scheduled reporting time will be called in order of their general merit rank for document verification and seat allotment.
 - 5.3. Late candidates can be considered under special circumstances and only if vacancy exists even after allotment to all, who have reported within the stipulated schedule. In this regard, the decision of the Board will be final and binding to the candidate.
 - 5.4. The candidate himself/herself must report for counselling. **No other person can report for counselling on behalf of the candidate.**
 - 5.5. The candidate must produce the following documents in original.
 - 5.5.1. Registration form for counselling
 - 5.5.2. Rank card.
 - 5.5.3. Mark sheet of class-X
 - 5.5.4. Mark sheet of class-XII
 - 5.5.5. SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PwD certificate, if applicable.
 - 5.6. If a seat is allotted, the candidate will have to pay requisite provisional admission fees at the counselling venue. Payment can be done by debit card/ credit card/ cash.
 - 5.7. The amount of provisional admission fees is given in [annexure-II](#).

5.8. If any candidate is found not prepared to make the payment due to any reason, his/her allotment will be cancelled immediately, and the seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate.

7. Reporting to the Presidency University:

7.1. All provisionally admitted candidates must report to the Presidency University by **25th September 2019** during office hours with Provisional Admission Letter and all original documents/credentials.

7.2. As per the Presidency University norms, following five affidavits on Non-judicial Stamp paper of Rs. 10 or above, duly signed by the candidate and his/her guardians, will have to be submitted to the University. Texts of these affidavits are provided in the admissions page of the university website (www.presiuniv.ac.in/web/admission.php).

7.3. Students already admitted in other institutions/ universities will have to submit the admission cancellation certificate/ transfer certificate from the respective college/university within the date as is stipulated by the Presidency University.

7.4. The admission of any candidate will stand cancelled for

7.4.1. Not regularly attending classes and not having an attendance record of 75% in first two (2) weeks from the commencement of classes.

7.4.2. Found guilty of any breach of discipline during the above-mentioned period & / or having cases / enquiries under any point of law pending either from the Institution last attended or elsewhere.

7.4.3. Non-submission of the statutory documents (declarations/affidavit) within the stipulated time.
